TEXAS RRC RULE 8 UPDATE


Many Texas operators still rely on paper forms and spreadsheets to track waste, which makes compliance labor-intensive and error-prone. Manually managing these new requirements can lead to missing data, mistakes, and costly violations.

An updated Rule 8 was adopted by the Texas RRC on December 17, 2024. New regulations go into effect July 1, 2025

- **Waste Profile Forms:** A unique Waste Profile Form must be completed for each oil & gas waste type at each site (detailing the waste characterization and classification), and records must be retained for at least 3 years by both the producer and the receiver.
- **Waste Manifests:** Every load of oil & gas waste transported off-lease now requires an Oil & Gas Waste Manifest with detailed info including generator identity, location (lease/facility), waste profile ID, destination facility, transporter permit, waste type & volume, shipment date, and signatures of the generator, driver, and receiver. *In short, no truck can leave the site without a properly documented manifest.*
- **Electronic Records Allowed:** The RRC permits electronic systems for manifests and profiles (in lieu of paper) as long as data is accessible to the Commission and all parties involved. This is a huge opportunity to go digital, but many companies haven't adopted a capable system yet.
- **Penalty Risks:** Non-compliance can result in serious fines per infraction e.g. \$2,500 for using an unpermitted hauler or accepting unauthorized waste, \$1,000 for failing to maintain records or submit required reports. *These add up quickly and can even halt operations*.

Bottom Line: Compliance under Rule 8 demands accurate, timely paperwork for every waste stream and haul. Without automation, this creates a mountain of admin work and risk for O&G producers and waste facilities in Texas.


